

# Aalen University – A Leader in Applied Research

When it comes to research, Aalen University is one of the leading Universities of Applied Sciences in Germany. The annual research budget exceeds more than 15 Million Euro and the scientific output adds up to more than 300 publications and patents per year.

Currently, more than 150 scientists are receiving funding from external sources and more than 60 are pursuing a doctorate. Research infrastructure includes among others two new, state-of-the-art research centers and modern research equipment, which is upgraded continuously.

Research activities tackle major societal challenges including climate change, energy and resource efficiency, sustainable mobility and digitalization. Key research areas are "Advanced Materials and Manufacturing" and "Photonics". Additional activities include topics such as "Intelligent Mechatronic Systems", "Analytical and Organic Chemistry" or "Economic and Social Innovations in Transition". Current crosscutting topics are "Applied Machine Learning/Data Science" or Industry 4.0.

Research is performed within an established network of renowned academic research institutions and leading global companies, many of which are located in nearby neighborhoods such as ZEISS, VARTA, Voith, Paul Hartmann or MAPAL.
